WELCOME

On Sunday 6th November at the AGM I agreed to take on the position of Club Secretary. I joined the Bowls Club last year and have been made welcome in the clubhouse and on the green. Playing in Ladies and Mixed matches I got to know a lot of members but there will be some who have no idea who I am. So here is a brief run down....

I was Manager of various Builders Merchants in King's Lynn (a woman in a man's world). Monks, Harcross & Crossleys. I had to work my way up from Admin Officer to earn this position and I can assure you it wasn't easy. Starting at 6 am and finishing at 6 pm with builders phoning for prices in the evenings and a young family to look after I stuck it for 10 years when I decided it was too much for the pay I received.

I decided to open my own business running Sage Accounting Systems employing several staff spread around various local Brethen businesses. This proved very successful enabling me to buy my second home and rent out my first.

Following retirement in 2003 I took up golf - playing at Ryston Park Golf Club and shortly afterwards I was asked if I would take the Club Treasurer position which I did for 10 years until I decided to take some time out.

I became the Club Photographer, Press Officer and then created a Monthly Newsletter which I emailed to all members to keep them posted and up to date. This proved very popular and I encouraged each of the Captains to write a short piece each month, along with the Greenkeeper, the Social Event Leader etc.

In 2013 I was elected Ladies Captain but the highlight was to come three years later.

In 2016 I was given the honour of becoming Club Captain – the first lady in Norfolk to ever be offered the position of Club Captain (Covering both the Mens & Ladies section). During my time as Club Captain I brought in new membership fees for Under 40's to encourage youngsters to join the club. Suddenly we had loads of lads wanting to join and are still members.

In 2018 I took over as Club Secretary looking after all aspects of the club acting as a Manager.

After covid it became difficult to manage home and work so I retired.

I'm still a member at Ryston Park and a very active golfer winning 5 cups this year.

So now I'm giving some of my time to Shouldham Bowls & Social Club as your Club Secretary.
